Nagoya University adopts an academic year system of fall admissions of certain students, a majority of whom are students of international programs. The fall graduation ceremony of Nagoya University was taken place on Sep 27, 2019, at the Toyoda Auditorium. Fourteen international students graduated from the School of Agriculture or the Graduate School of Bioagricultural Sciences. Bachelor's degree was each given to 4 students of Global 30 International Programs (G30); Master's degree to 4 students of G30 or inter Asia-Africa Advanced Agriculture Program (i4A); Doctoral degree to 3 students of i4A and 3 students of Transnational Doctoral Programs for Leading Professionals in Asian Countries (Asian Satellite Campuses Institute, ASCI).
