3	Recruitment details	<p>[Duties (Description of work, courses in charge, etc.)]</p> <p>The Graduate School of Bioagricultural Sciences, Nagoya University, has positioned "Bioagricultural Sciences" as a comprehensive academic field that aims to expand the foundations of life science, to make advanced use of biological functions and resources, to create and preserve a symbiotic environment for life, and to develop human society in harmony with the environment through sustainable biological production and technological development of advanced life sciences. Furthermore, our mission is to pursue truth through creative research activities and contribute to the formation, accumulation, and inheritance of the world's leading intellectual assets in life science and agriculture.</p> <p>The Department of Plant Production Sciences aims to contribute to the qualitative improvement of food, the environment, and health through the improvement of plant functions and productivity in response to domestic and international food supply and demand, the diversification of plant resource use, and global environmental changes. The department also aims to engage in research and development of scientific and practical technologies in agriculture based on life sciences, and to develop human resources with advanced expertise, broad agricultural background, and international mindedness, backed by theories of life and social sciences.</p> <p>The laboratories related to plant pathology (Laboratory of Plant Pathology and Laboratory of Plant Immunology) in this department are in charge of education related to Plant Pathology in the Graduate School of Bioagricultural Sciences and the Faculty of Agriculture. These laboratories perform research and education aimed at contributing to the development of plant pathology and plant protection by elucidating plant defense mechanisms in the interaction between plants and pathogens, pathogen infection mechanisms, disease control methods, etc.</p>

This position is open to individuals with outstanding research achievements in plant pathology or related fields who can contribute to the development of the research field and the department. In addition, the successful candidate will have a sense of responsibility and a cooperative attitude toward education, research guidance, and administration of the graduate and undergraduate schools based on the mission and objectives of the graduate school and the department as described above.
